Year 1 - Winter

may take an options course

Year 1 – Spring/Summer

take options courses (should have completed a minimum of 6 courses by the end of summer term)

Year 2 – Fall

complete options courses (must have all but the final course completed by the end of fall term)

Year 2 - Winter

SOWK 721 Integrative Research Colloquia (final course, only offered once per year, all other coursework must be completed prior to taking this course)

Note:

1. Options courses may include PhD level courses taken outside the Faculty of Social Work, courses taken through the Western Dean's Agreement (max 2) or Independent Study Courses (max 2). Permission must be obtained from your advisor/supervisor, the instructor and the PhD program coordinator. Paperwork may need to be completed for these courses and course outlines must be submitted to the PhD Program Coordinator.
2. Some 600 level (Master's level) courses may be eligible with modifications to meet PhD level expectations. Check with the PhD Program Coordinator.
